About the programme:

1. The Future Leaders Programme provides mentoring, practical support and skills development to young women
2. Students who are on the Future Leaders programme are primarily from decile 1-4 schools.
3. Young women enter the programme at year 10 and is assigned a mentor who works closely with her through to year 13.
4. Mentors are women who have volunteered their time to support the young women. They come from all over New Zealand, and come from a range of cultures, professions and ages.
5. Our aim is for the young women on the Future Leaders programme to become capable and confident leaders in many areas of society, acting as role models for other young people and taking their leadership skills back into their communities.
